

School Uniform Policy

It is an expectation at Urunga Public School that all students wear full school uniform, including our school hat every day. We encourage our students to wear our uniform with pride. If anyone is experiencing financial hardship and is finding it difficult to pay for uniforms, please contact the principal to organise a suitable payment plan.

Our school uniforms are available for our canteen from Wednesday's to Friday's from 8.30am to midday. Outside of these hours, parents can complete an order form and attach payment for collection at agreed times. Order forms are available from our office. Our uniform shop is co-ordinated and financed by our P&C.

Navy blue with sky blue panelling collared polo shirt (with school emblem)

Tights may be worn under the uniform, however, they must be NAVY (not black).
