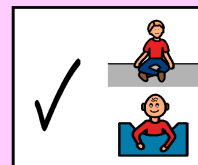

UPDATE FAMILY CONTACT INFORMATION

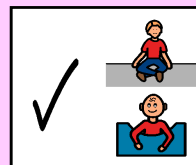
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STAGE 3 STUDENTS DRAWING FUNDRAISER

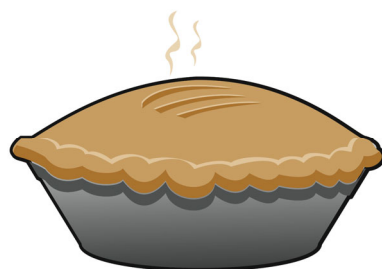


PIE DRIVE

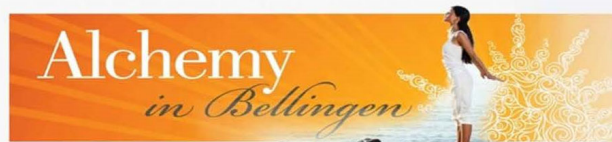
Motorists should be aware of hefty fines for offences detected in school zones.

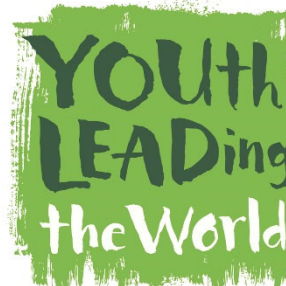



CHILD CARE SUBSIDY: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) is a government subsidy offered to eligible families as a reduction on fees. Applications for the CCS are made through your Centrelink online account through myGov. Please apply / update details for CCS if you haven't already done so. For more information on this process, visit education.gov.au/childcare

PLEASE NOTE: If children have a break between care of more than eight weeks (e.g. during the school term) their enrolment will be ceased. The Service will update enrolment details with Centrelink. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to check their child's enrolment status (notifications) in their myGov account and confirm enrolment details where necessary to access CCS. A new Complying Written Agreement will also need to be signed.
