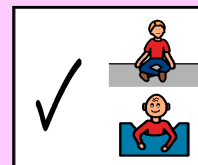
## NEWS FROM OUR PRINCIPAL MRS JANE MARTYN

## NEWS FROM OUR COMMUNITY LIAISON OFFICER JENNY LUXON

### 3D PRINTING IN 5/6 MAROON

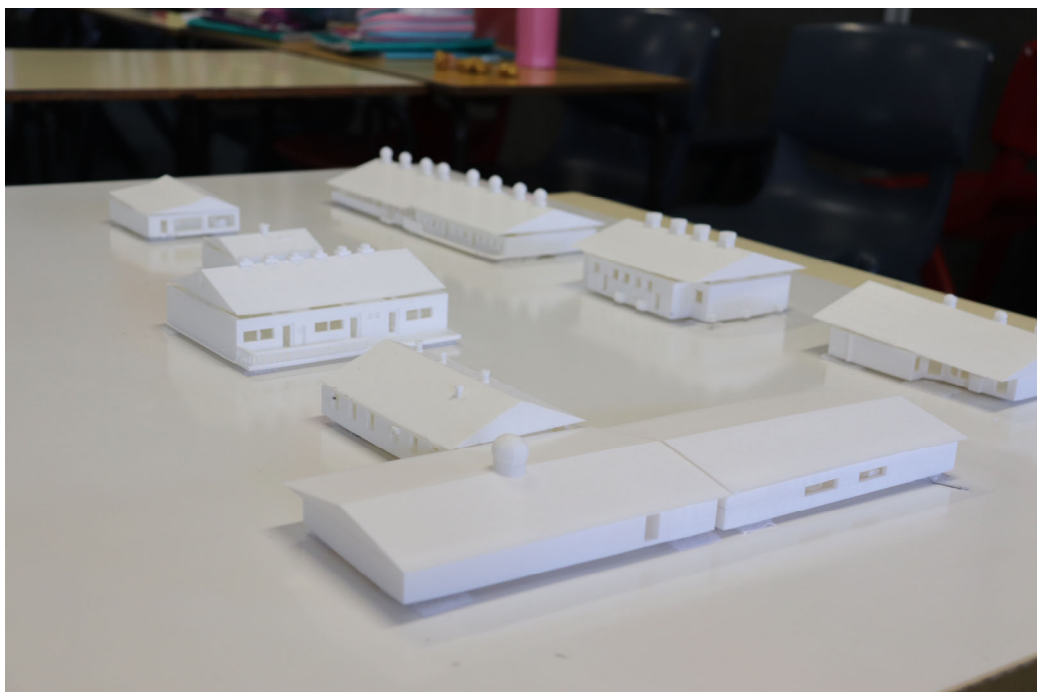
5/6 Maroon are proud owners of a brand new school... well not quite. As a part of our mathematics unit of work, students were set the major task of accurately sketching details, measuring, scaling and printing the entire school and every room within its walls. This involved students getting into small teams and focusing on one building each. After sketching and counting important details such as windows and doors, they used trundle wheels and metre rulers to accurately measure the area and perimeter of their building. Whilst Mr Ticli was thinking about all of the issues associated with children climbing up onto the roof, we resorted to estimation, thereby agreeing on a reasonable height for each room and roof.

From this point, students were required to scale down their measurements and replicate their work using a cloud-based program called Tinkercad. The most accurate and workable representation was selected from each group and downloaded as an STL file. This file was then uploaded for 3D printing and then printed in white PLA (Polylactic acid). This material was selected due to the rigidity, lower melting point and the fact that it is made from biodegradable corn starch – very friendly 😊

This unit of work covered a huge number of mathematical concepts and cross-curricular elements of work such as our science unit on Solids, Liquids and Gasses.

We hope parents, students and teachers come by to have a look at our work.

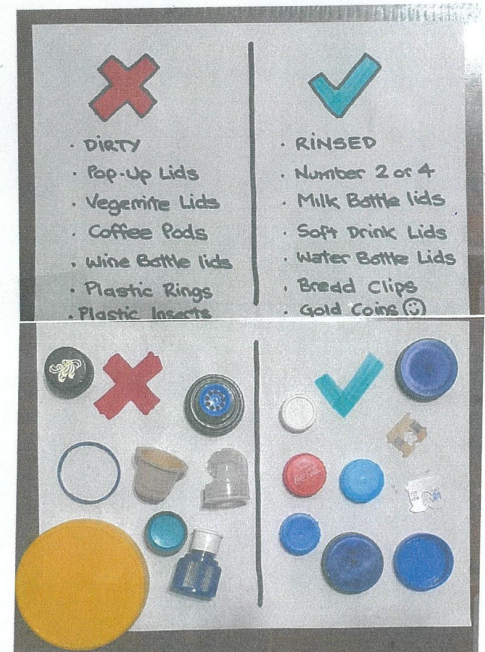

Please apply / update details for CCS if you haven't already done so. For more information on this process, visit [education.gov.au/childcare](http://education.gov.au/childcare)

**PLEASE NOTE:** If children have a break between care of more than eight weeks (e.g. during the school term) their enrolment will be ceased. The Service will update enrolment details with Centrelink. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to check their child's enrolment status (notifications) in their myGov account and confirm enrolment details where necessary to access CCS. A new Complying Written Agreement will also need to be signed.
